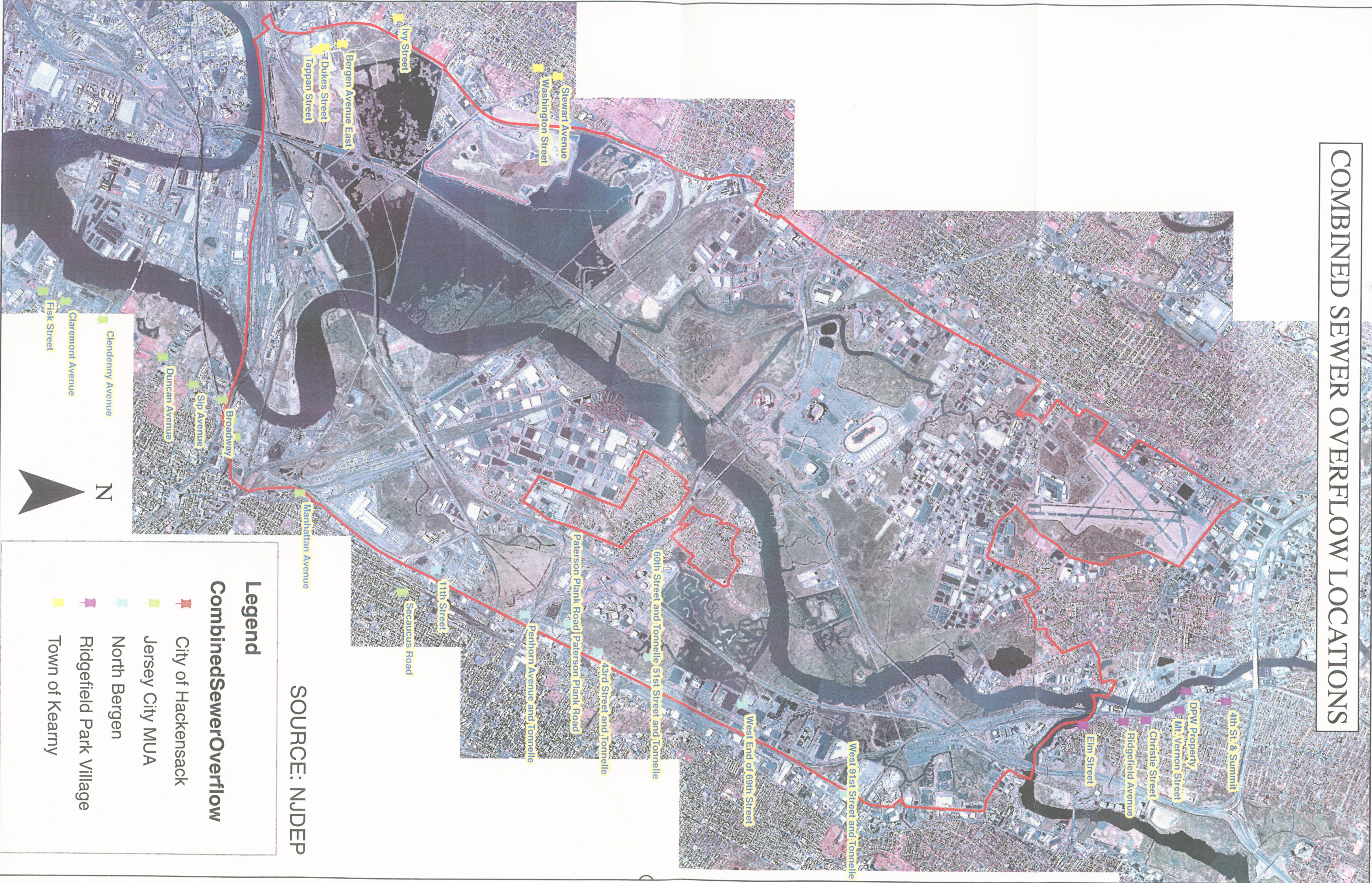


COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOW LOCATIONS

Transmitted to your attention, as an attached file, is an Excel Spread sheet the provides the information we have on file for the communities of interest. This information reflects, to our best knowledge, the CSO Points that have been authorized under the General Permit for CSS. Some of the communities are consolidating or eliminating some of the CSO Points. The table lists CSO Points that may have since been eliminated.

As the Solids/Floatables Control Measures are being implemented, some CSO Points are eliminated. This process is ongoing. More CSO Points may be eliminated between when the Individual Authorizations were issued

(2004) to the permittee and when the plans have been fully implemented.

We will correct the administrative records in the future. This information does give you a understanding of the baseline of what CSO Points did exist.




